# **French Open**

### **Scoring - Males**

Straight sets win – 5 points

Four set win – 4 points

Five set win – 3 points

Five set loss – 2 points

Four set loss – 1 point

### **Scoring Females**

Straight sets win – 5 points

Three set win – 3 points

Three set loss – 1 point

#### **Both Male and Female**

Win the Grandslam – 10 points

If unseeded player beats a seed – 3 points.

If lower seed player beats a higher seeded player – 1 point.

#### **Bonuses**

6-0 set – 3 points

6-1 set – 2 points

6-2 set -1 point

## Round win bonuses (i.e bonus points for making it into the second week)

4<sup>th</sup> round – 1 point

Quarter Finals – 2 points

Semi-finals – 3 points

Runner-up – 5 points

#### Substitute player

- The majority voted for 'The idea for a substitute player'. (73.9%)
